

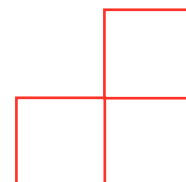

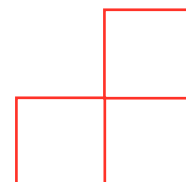


## COURSE INFORMATION

## APPLICATION STEPS

<b>NOMINATION</b>	Students cannot apply by themselves, they must be nominated by their International Office by filling in <a href="#">this form</a> . Semester 1: April 30 <sup>th</sup> 2023 Semester 2: October 1 <sup>st</sup> 2023  <b>Dentistry, Nursing and Physiotherapy internships:</b> Nominations regardless of the semester in which the stay will take place, must be done before April 30 <sup>th</sup> 2023.
<b>ONLINE APPLICATION</b>	Once nominated, students will receive a confirmation from our International Office, together with an incoming student guide and a link to do their online application on our MoveOn platform.  Semester 1: May 1 <sup>st</sup> to May 31 <sup>st</sup> 2023 Semester 2: October 1 <sup>st</sup> to October 31 <sup>st</sup> 2023  <u>Students are not required to select their classes at this point yet.</u>
<b>ACCEPTATION</b>	Once their application is completed, students will receive the list of classes available and are assigned an International tutor to manage their academic questions.  <b>WARNING:</b> selected classes before the arrival can be modified during the first week of the stay, due to last minute timetable modifications.
<b>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR ERASMUS STUDENTS</b>	Certificate of Stay and Learning Agreements must be provided by the university of origin and will be signed by the international office upon arrival.



## COURSES SELECTION

<b>ECTS</b>	<p>There is a maximum number of ECTS credits that can be selected depending on the duration of stay at UE Valencia:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>1 Semester: 30 ECTS</b> <b>2 Semesters: 60 ECTS</b></p> <p>One subject usually represents 6 ECTS, meaning students can choose 5 subjects per semester. We will ask student to also choose two additional classes in case there is no place left in their first choice.</p>
<b>Language classes</b>	<p>UEV offers online English and Spanish classes (level A1, A2, B1 and B2). Registration for those classes are made during the first weeks of the stay via the webpage of the university.</p>
<b>English classes</b>	<p style="text-align: center;">UEV offers 5 degrees taught in English:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Business</b> <b>International Relations</b> <b>Dentistry</b> <b>Translation</b> <b>Tourism management</b></p> <p>Due to the high demand on those programs, we cannot guarantee seats in those English classes and students may have no other option than following the Spanish equivalent. That is why a B2 in Spanish is highly recommended.</p>
<b>Internships</b>	<p>The Career Department in UEV publishes internships offers in our internal platform. Exchange students have access to this platform and can apply for internships like any other UEV student. The university can manage the internship agreement.</p> <p>Except for Nursing and Physiotherapy internships provided in one of our partner clinics, for other areas the student is responsible to find, choose and get employed by a company.</p>

## TRAVEL ACCOMODATION

<b>Visa Requirements</b>	<p>Compulsory for non-EU students, please check your student's visa requirements at the Spanish Embassy or Consulate in your home Country.</p>
<b>Health Insurance</b>	<p>Students are responsible for obtaining International health insurance valid throughout their stay in Spain/Europe. They must provide the International Office with a copy of their insurance upon their arrival. We do recommend an insurance company in our guide for incoming students.</p>
<b>Accommodation</b>	<p>UEV does not have any housing service. Accommodation is the responsibility of the student who can find useful tips (websites, recommendation...) in the Incoming guide for students.</p>
