- I. Participants were introduced.
- II. Meeting minutes of February 20, 2018 were reviewed. Dr Harding motioned for approval. Mr. Michael Clayton seconded. Minutes were approved unanimously.
- III. Discussion of the vision of the Faculty of each school for instructional technology support. See submitted vision and discussion elements on next page.
- IV. Updates: Neil Schroeder**
 - a. Printer installation will be substantially completed by the end of May. No further discussion was raised by the group.
- V. Updates: Dr. Cheryl Anderson**
 - a. Interactive Classroom Response Systems. Criteria for selection established. Poll Everywhere and Top Hat are being considered. Trial of Top Hat will be undertaken. Price and feature differences are substantial.
 - b. Blackboard upgrade completed. The remainder of blackboard upgrades are flexible deployment and dates have not been selected. Nursing and EAP are concerns due to the heavy reliance on Blackboard.
 - c. Research Software. First meeting is scheduled.
 - d. Dir, Instr Tech & Instr Tech/Bb Admin positions pending hire.

 - a. Password policy will be updated in June. Some discussion followed on appropriate lengths or strength criteria.
