Living on campus provides students more chances to focus on their studies, make study groups, and get to class on time. While on campus, students can take advantage of the many study spaces, tutoring services and more.



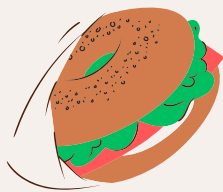
## SAFETY & SECURITY

Live in University owned and operated properties with access to professional and peer housing staff and the dedicated UIW Police Department 24/7.



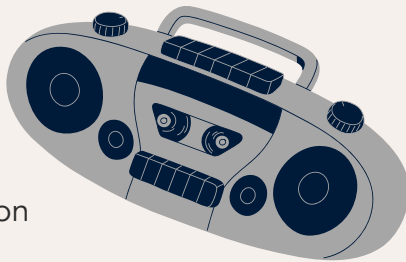
## LIVE! LAUGH! EAT!

# DUBUIS



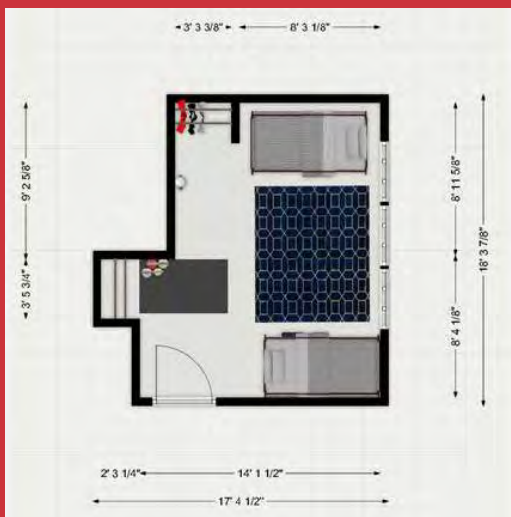
**VIRTUAL TOUR**

# HILLSIDE



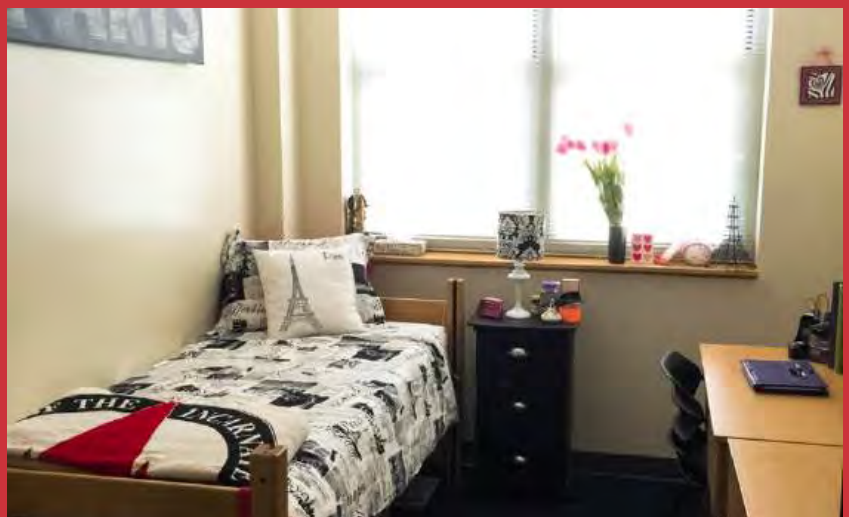
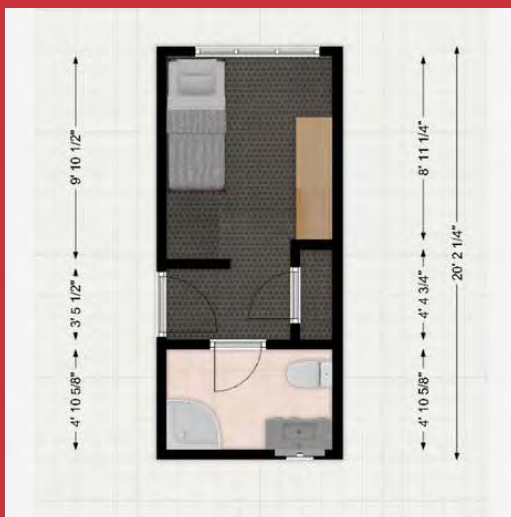
**VIRTUAL TOUR**

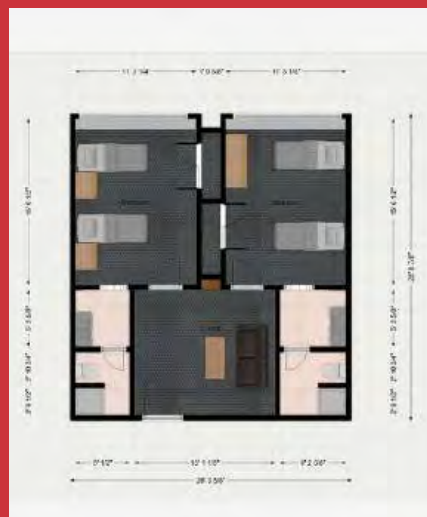

### 3. COMPLETE HOUSING APPLICATION

- Via GoUIW: Student Housing Portal

### 4. SELECT YOUR ROOM THROUGH JUNE 15\*

### 5. SUBMIT MENINGITIS VACCINATION RECORD

- Submit to registrar@uiwtx.edu

### 6. CHECK YOUR UIW EMAIL FOR MOVE-IN UPDATES
