Section 1 – Spring 2023 Closing

- Review any holds you may have – check with advising, the business office, financial aid, etc.
- Review your own departure plans, May is a few weeks away.
- Speak with your RA in regard to any questions about your departure.
- Meal Points will not roll, please use them.
- Ensure all personal information is up to date on Banner
- **Please monitor your Cardinal Email**

Check-Out Dates

- **Non-Graduating Residents:** All residence halls will close on 05/05/2023 (Friday) @ 4:00 PM
- **Graduating Residents:** All residence halls will close on 05/08/2023 (Monday) @ 1:00 PM.
- **International Residents:** All residence halls will close on 05/10/2023 (Wednesday) @ 1:00 PM.

Checking Out of Your Room

- Schedule a checkout time with your RA
 - At the time of check out, all your personal items should be removed and any of your trash brought to trash cans
- Check out signups will be posted outside your RAs door starting Monday, April 17th
- ALL Checkout times must be scheduled by Friday April 28th
- Make sure that ALL belongings and trash are removed from your room.
- Complete closing paperwork and turn-in key at checkout time

Closing Procedures

- Complete all task items on the departure form before submitting – Your RA will have knowledge on this form
- Examples
 - Clean/pickup around restroom area
 - All water is off
 - All lights are off
 - All windows are shut
 - Take all trash out
 - All personal items removed

Condition of room at time of check-out

- Your room (room side) must be completely empty by the time of your check-out.
- Clean (no food, trash, or unwanted items)
- Turn off all water faucets
- Turn off all lights
- Properly dispose of all trash
- Shut & lock all windows
- Close all window shades

Apartment Living


- Please coordinate amongst all roommates/suitemates regarding:
 - Left over food
 - Restrooms
 - Kitchen utensils, cooking implements, etc.
- It should not be expected for the last person to take care of your own items left behind!
- Support each other during the move out process!

Abandoned Items

- Any items left in room or suite after the residence hall closes are considered abandoned and will be donated to charity or disposed of **(Residence Life does not store any belongings).**

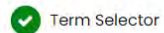

Meningitis Immunization

Effective October 1, 2013, a change to Texas State law (SB 62) mandates that all entering students under the age of 22 provide a certificate signed by a health care provider or an official immunization record verifying that a student has been vaccinated against bacterial meningitis, or has received a booster during the five years preceding admission to the University.

The meningococcal conjugate (MenACWY) vaccine is required for all entering students. If the student received a dose of MenACWY before their 16th birthday, they need a booster shot for maximum protection before going to college.

The vaccine must be received **prior to the 10th day before the first day of the semester**. The vaccine is available through UIW Student Health Services utilizing the School Health Insurance Plan or for a fee of \$145.00. It is also available through your local health department, your Primary Care Physician, HEB, Walgreens, CVS and many other convenient care centers. Pricing will vary and is covered by most private health insurance at city-wide pharmacies.

Your meningitis records can be submitted to the Document Receiving office by emailing your record in PDF format to admissiondocs@uiwtx.edu. Be sure to include your PIDM or date of birth.

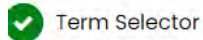

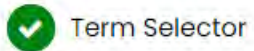



Room Reservation Tips and Tricks

- Roommate Pairings

- You may only select a roommate – NOT suitemates
- A roommate is the person who you would be sharing the same room with and applies to DOUBLE rooms
- You cannot select through the Roommate Groups who will be in an adjoining room

- Room Selection

- If you do not Renew your room (and are eligible), you will be placed in a later time slot.
- Our suggestion is to renew your room and go through the Room Change process that occurs during the Summer. Our office will do everything we can to grant room changes through the entire summer.

- **Residents interested in Summer Housing**

Summer Housing Eligibility

- To be eligible for summer housing, residents must be:
 - Enrolled in Summer coursework OR Fall Semester.
 - Be enrolled as a full-time student (12 credit hours undergraduate/ 6 credit hours for graduate students) for the Fall Semester.
 - Please note – summer applications are separate from fall applications! An application must be on file for each of these semesters
 - All summer residents are required to have a meal plan except for Maymester residents

Submit a Request to Change Rooms

The room change process occurs four times during the academic year. We will gladly accept room changes during active periods.

Note, all requests will be reviewed in the order received. While we make every effort to honor requests, changes are dependent upon room availability.

Active Room Change Request Periods:

- June 1 – July 15 (Fall Semester)
 - **New Extended Request period to August 1, 2020**
- August (Fall semester) – First week of classes
- November (Spring Semester)
- January (Spring semester) – First week of classes

Make a Change to Your Meal Plan

The meal plan change process occurs twice during the academic year. We will gladly accept room changes during active periods.

Note that changes **CANNOT** occur outside meal plan change period
