Reflection

Discussion Questions:

- 1. When you think about the pandemic and our response to it, what most concerns you? What brings you comfort?
- 2. How can we remain close to each other, to the people we serve, and to God during this time of isolation?

General Intercessions

Leader: Let us now turn our thoughts into prayer for the Church and for the world. Let us pray to Him, saying: Lord Jesus, hear our prayer.

Leader: Lord Jesus, you became like us in all things but sin; teach us how to share with others their joys and sorrows during this difficult times so that our love may grow deeper every day [Pause for silent prayer], We pray to the Lord. **R/.**

Leader: Help us to continue feeding the hungry and caring for the sick and the dying with compassionate courage [Pause for silent prayer], We pray to the Lord. **R/.**

Leader: Inspire us to find ways to support nurses, doctors, public servants, and all those who are risking their lives to keep us healthy, fed, and secure [Pause for silent prayer], We pray to the Lord. **R/.**

Leader: You raised Lazarus from the sleep of death, grant that those who have died during this crisis may rise again and give their loved ones consolation and peace [Pause for silent prayer], We pray to the Lord. **R/.**

Leader: Let us take a time of silence to call to mind those people, thoughts, feelings, and moments in our lives that need God the most. [Pause for silent prayer].

Leader: As we conclude this time together, let us pray together the prayer that Jesus taught us.



All: Our Father...

Leader: Let us close with the Holy Father's Prayer to Mary

O Mary, you shine continuously on our journey as a sign of salvation and hope.

We entrust ourselves to you, Health of the Sick.

At the foot of the Cross you participated in Jesus' pain, with steadfast faith.

You, Salvation of the Roman People, know what we need.

We are certain that you will provide, so that, as you did at Cana of Galilee, joy and feasting might return after this moment of trial.

> Help us, Mother of Divine Love, to conform ourselves to the Father's will and to do what Jesus tells us:

He who took our sufferings upon Himself, and bore our sorrows to bring us, through the Cross, to the joy of the Resurrection.

Amen.

Leader: We seek refuge under your protection, O Holy Mother of God.

All: Do not despise our pleas – we who are put to the test – and deliver us from every danger, O glorious and blessed Virgin.

Leader: And may almighty God bless you, the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

All: Amen.
