


Academic Integrity Report



 Upload pictures, emails, documentation or any related communication. Include facts, such as, date, time, name(s), student ID numbers



- Direct statements indicating distress
- Injury, illness, or hospitalization
- Exaggerated personality traits
- Upload related facts and emails







- Inappropriate and/or disruptive conduct
- Violations of Student Code of Conduct
- Fill out incident report with all facts, such as, date, time, name(s), student ID numbers



Title IX Report

- Sexual harassment
- Sexual assault, exploitation
- Stalking
- Relationship violence (including dating and domestic violence)



Classroom Management

Do not submit classroom management concerns:



 Not paying attention, excessive talking and/or lack of respect in class



OFFICE OF STUDENT ADVOCACY AND ACCOUNTABILITY







- Report Policy Violations
- Document the student concern or incident



- Get the names of individual(s) involved
- Record important information
- Identify student(s) with a student ID, State ID, or Driver's license, and contact phone number



Use your cell phone to take notes for reporting concern or incident:



REPORT

- Timeline, location, witnesses
- Describe in detail the behavior, scene or situation with facts only
- Include pictures, emails, documentation and/or any related communication

Report Location Link



After Report is Submitted

- Report is reviewed by Office of Student Advocacy and Accountability (OSAA)
- Action is taken by OSAA, or CARE Team
- Student is contacted to address the concern
- OSAA does not contact faculty/staff with updates
- Faculty/ Staff may be contacted only if additional information is needed
