University of the Incarnate Word Status Sanction Guidelines – Alcohol and Other Drugs

The following guidelines have been developed to promote transparency regarding status, or inactive, sanctions. Status sanctions are indicators not only of the severity of violations of University policies, but as a marker of the student's standing at the institution. This non-exhaustive list reflects possible status sanctions for **first-time violations**, and should not be treated as absolute, but as a reference so that students can understand where hearing officers are starting from when evaluating potential violations. Hearing officers have the discretion to consider other aggravating or mitigating factors in their final determinations of appropriate status sanctions on a case-by-case basis, including previous conduct history and other concurrent violations of policy.
